

Coordination mechanism

Pursuant to the same above-mentioned article, States Parties have to establish or designate a coordination mechanism within government to facilitate related action in different sectors and at different levels.

The role of the coordination mechanism is to:

- support the implementation of the Convention in all government sectors and levels
- coordinate the various focal points
- involve the representative bodies (health, employment, justice, etc.).

In Belgium, the coordination mechanism has been established within the following federal administration: Federal Public Service Social Security, Directorate General Strategy and Research.
