Dear Ms Cloosen,

Thank you very much for your email. We wanted to get in touch with you because this file is very important for our organisation and our members, especially as women and girls with disabilities are at higher risk of violence and face more challenges in reporting and accessing justice. My colleague from the Belgian Disability Forum is in copy of this email.

Attached you can find our proposed amendments. They focus on 3 key matters:

- Criminalisation of forced sterilisation
- Enhanced provisions on accessibility, adequate support and training of professionals
- Requirement of disaggregation of data by disability and targeted research on violence against women and girls with disabilities

For more information on violence against by women and girls with disabilities, I enclosed our position paper on the topic.

Regarding our call for the criminalisation of forced sterilisations, I am sending you a legal advice on the topic, which also examines the competence of the EU to legislate on the subject.

We are aware that this file will take time to be discussed in the Council and the European Parliament. In this perspective, we would appreciate an opportunity to meet with you to further discuss our proposals – also well in advance of the Belgian presidency, and as Belgium is one of the Member States with legislation protecting people with disabilities against forced sterilisation.
