

Dear Olivier,

Thank you for your comments. The document was also discussed at the Executive meeting last week and the final version will be added to our application for the 2019 grant of the Commission.

Here are the answers to your questions:

- RVJ is the “Rights, Justice, and Values” Programme of the European Commission. It is the continuation of the Rights Equality and Citizenship Programme from which EDF currently receives the operating grant
- On the CEDAW committee, this point was also raised by the executive, and certainly when EDF members want to engage we can support. But we have no human or financial resources for extra work/training on this in 2019.
- The point on the EDF governing bodies means that we run our meetings well. In 2018 and 2019 we have actions regarding accessibility (the policy) and reviewing the costs and looking for savings.
- On the website, the current website is quite out of date already, due to a longer than planned implementation. The current website has severe security issues, that have already been exploited. The content management system is also out of date and will stop being supported by the provider soon. The new website will solve these risks.
