#### Scope and Objectives

#### ΕN

The red thread of this conference is mobility and accessibility for people with disabilities, which in the first panel is reflected in the contributions leading to awareness of the rights of people with disabilities, especially on the field of accessibility and mobility, which the European Commission has highlighted in the recent years with the adoption of the Directive (EU) 2019/882 on accessibility requirements for products and services, which needs to be transposed into national law by 28th June 2022. Therefore, the introductory part of the conference is intended to present Slovenian projects that have been successfully implemented so far, which can be permanently developed and will be essential to the people with disabilities in their lives.

The second panel will present a project of the European Commission, which together with the Member States has successfully implemented the EU Disability Card project, which addresses the issue of more available accessibility for the people with disabilities when traveling in the countries of the European Union. The card offers more favourable products and services for people with disabilities within the individual country that participated in the project. There have been 8 of these countries so far, and one of them was Slovenia, which was the first to complete the project. In the second part, we want to present the importance of this project, good practices, and the importance of expanding the card to the entire EU.

In the final part of the conference, the third panel will present the most current topic, the EU Strategy on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities for 2021 - 2030, which is based on the previous strategy and intervene in all areas of the life of people with disabilities, even in the time of crisis, and take care for their integration into society in all areas of their lives. The main focus will be on the red thread of the conference, accessibility, which is a broad concept and includes access to goods, digitalization, information and communication technologies, education, employment, health, full participation in society, and last but not least, the implementation of the EU Disability Card in even greater scale, as was originally intended goal. All of this is indirectly linked to the implementation and realisation of the commitment made at the ratification of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.

#### **General objectives:**

- 1. The Conference will contribute to raising awareness of the rights of people with disabilities, in particular from the field of accessibility and mobility.
- 2. The exchange of good practices / successful projects in the European Union is an important aspect for the active development of EU society as a whole.
- 3. It will pursue the path set in recent years by the European Commission, highlighting in particular the importance of Directive (EU) 2019/882 on accessibility requirements for products and services.
- 4. Promoting recommendation of the new European Strategy on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities 2021-2030 about the EU Disability Card benefits and recognizing the importance of extending the card to all EU Member States.
- 5. Recognizing the importance of the implementation of new European legislation, the European Strategy on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities 2021-2030, which results from the implementation of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities.
