Thus, for using the same procedure, and being able to accept other votes than agreement, another step is necessary. This is an agreement of doing our Annual General Assembly Procedure via e-mail exchange. This step will be presented for adoption in presence of the lawyer supporting us during the session on 23rd April.
